Each invitee, or invitee's team of up to three, must bring three bottles of the EXACT SAME brand and vintage Australian Red wine. For example, an invitee or team could bring three bottles of Brokenwood Wines Pinot Noir, Hunter Valley, 2006.

Upon arrival, all bottles will be given to the Hosts, who will wrap two of the bottles to conceal the wine's identity. The two wrapped bottles will have a number randomly assigned to them and will then be set out for tasting. The third bottle will be left unopened and will not be tasted or displayed.

The wines will be rated by the participants on a taste scale of 1 to 5. At the end of the tasting period, score cards will be collected and ratings tallied.

The teams that brought the top three favorite wines will take home everyone's third unopened bottle of wine. The team that brought the least favorite bottle of wine will take back its unopened bottle of wine.
